Must be a Kentucky resident and a member in good standing of an affiliated Baptist church in friendly cooperation with the Kentucky Baptist Convention.

Needy (as determined by the institution's financial aid officer – utilizing such guideline as the KHEAA program).

***Chester A. Igleheart Fund***

This scholarship is for financially-needy students attending ***Campbellsville University*** (25%) and for financially-needy students attending ***Southern Baptist Theological Seminary*** who are preparing for North American missionary service (37.5%) and International missionary service (37.5%).

***Clara McCartt Scholarship Fund***

This scholarship is for financially-needy students who are either (1) enrolled in a Church Secretary Degree program, OR (2) whose parent, grandparent or spouse is employed in a clerical/office support staff position at a Kentucky Baptist Convention or Southern Baptist Convention church, institution, agency or organization.
